# BELIZE QUALIFIED RETIREMENT PROGRAM (QRP)

#### WHO QUALIFIES?

- Any person 45 years or older
- Must have a retirement income of \$2K monthly or \$24K annually generated from a source outside of Belize (deposited into Belize account monthly or yearly)
- Retirement Income includes: Pension, Social Security Benefits, Inheritance, Personal Savings And other means of retirement income
- Must be able to remain in Belize for a minimum of 30 consecutive days annually.

#### BENEFITS

#### BELIZE RESIDENCY STATUS

QRP's and their dependents shall receive a QRP Resident Card to reside in Belize allowing multiple entries into the country without a Visa.

\*Resident card to be renewed annually \*

#### TAX EXEMPTIONS

QRP's shall be
exempted from all
taxes and duties on
income received from a
source outside of
Belize.

Including capital gains tax and inheritance tax.




#### **BANK ACCOUNT**

A retirement income of \$2K monthly or \$24K annually generated from a source outside of Belize must be deposited into Belize account monthly or yearly.

# TWO TYPES OF RESIDENCY

#### PERMANENT RESIDENCY

for persons who want to make Belize their home and will be staying in country for long period of time.

#### TEMPORARY RESIDENCY

for persons who have made or are in the process of making a substantial commercial investment (US\$250,000 or more) in Belize but due to commitments outside Belize cannot meet ordinary Permanent Residence restrictions.



### BELIZE RESIDENCY

#### WHO QUALIFIES?

- Everyone
- Legally reside in Belize for one consecutive year without leaving for more than 14 days.
- Renew Visitor's Permit Extension every 30 days
- You must prove to the Immigration Office that you have been and you will be able to continue being financially stable (bank accounts, income outside of Belize etc.
- "You have not been convicted by a court in any country of a criminal offence for which you may have been liable to a sentence of imprisonment of twelve months or more and has not received a free pardon in respect of the offence."

#### BENEFITS



#### PERMANENT RESIDENCE

After you've been approved by the Immigration Department for Belize residency, you will enjoy full residency rights.

#### BECOME A BELIZEAN CITIZEN

After you've been a
Permanent Residence for
a minimum of 5 years,
you qualify to apply for
citizenship.

Providing that upon being granted PR, you have not resided outside Belize for periods that exceed 30 days or 3 months in a year except for medical reasons.

#### BANK ACCOUNT BELIZEAN PASSPORT


One of the main requirements for opening up a bank account in Belize as a foreigner is having permanent residency status.

With your Belizean passport, you are able to travel throughout the Caricom countries without visas etc.

VISITOR'S PERMIT EXTENSION

Every 30 days \$100 USD per month for North Americans

PERMANENT RESIDENCY APPLICATION: US\$2,000 for US Citizens US\$1,500 for Canadian Citizens

Temporary Residence status is valid for only ONE year. The temporary residence fee is 1/5 of the permanent residence fee based on your nationality.

The temporary residence status may be renewed every year.

**QRP - Quick Approval** 

QRP - Duty free household, vehicle etc.

PR - no work permit needed after 1 Year

PR - Become a Belizean! Belizean passport (dual citizen)

Permanent Residence - monthly renewal until ONE year

Permanent Residence - downsize + pay duty on vehicle

QRP - can't work in Belize
